



ALE WEEKEND: 11TH – 13TH SEPTEMBER

INSIDE (FRIDAY)

Cloudbreaker (5.0%), Fyne Ales

A bold and refreshing IPA that captures the spirit of the peaks. Layers of zesty citrus, ripe tropical fruit, and juicy peach, complemented by a fresh, clean finish.

Dark Island (4.6%), Orkney Brewery

Exhibiting a ripe, fruity, chocolate nose, this beer is balanced by flavours of dark chocolate, figs and nuts from the combination of roasted malts and rich hops.

The Gloaming (4.4%) Loch Lomond Brewery

A dark reddish brown 80 shilling with rich roasted malts on the nose followed by flavours of biscuit and cereal on the palette followed by a sweet yet dry finish.

Natural Blonde (4.0%), Harviestoun Brewery

Straw in colour with moderate fruity hop aroma and flavour, light bitterness which builds in the aftertaste.

Oktoberfest (5.5%), Fyne Ales

Unfiltered and naturally settled, brewed with specialty malts for soft sweetness, gentle toast, and a full, malty body. Noble German hops add delicate floral notes, a touch of mandarin, and a rich, satisfying finish.
